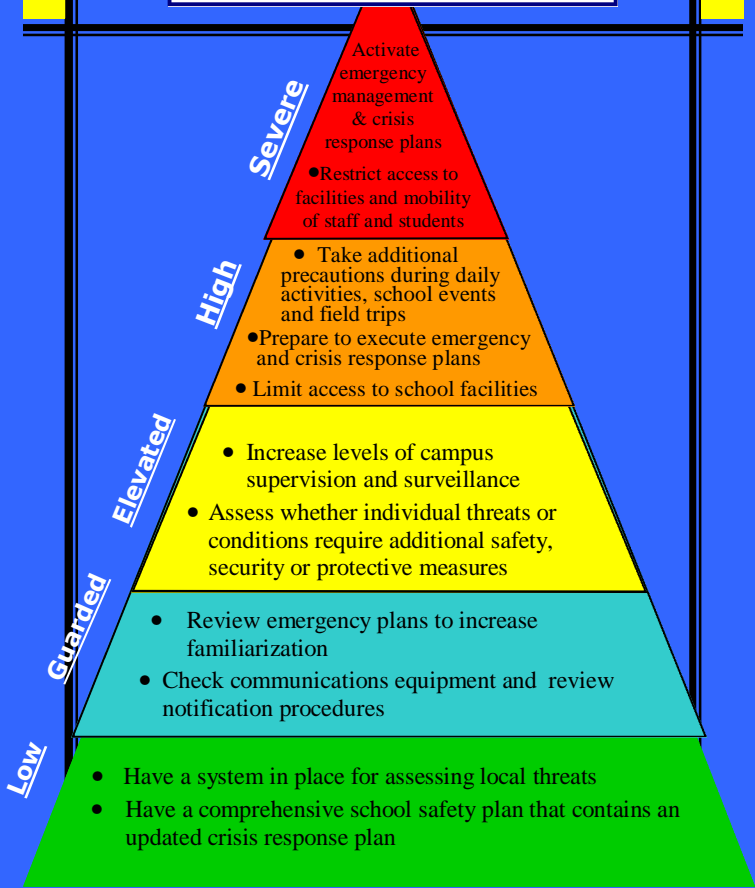
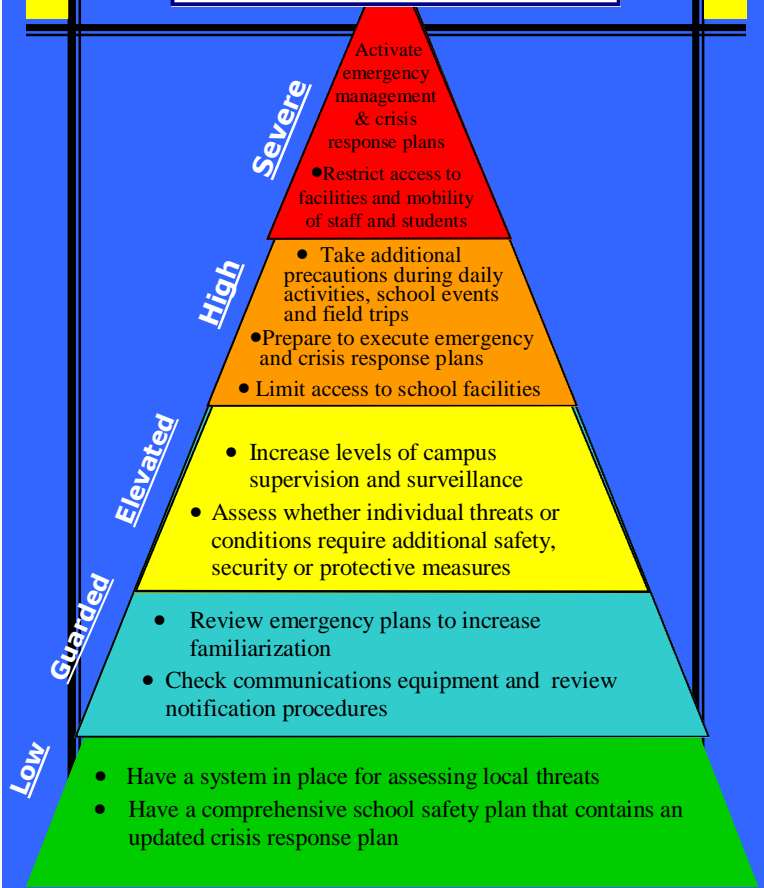


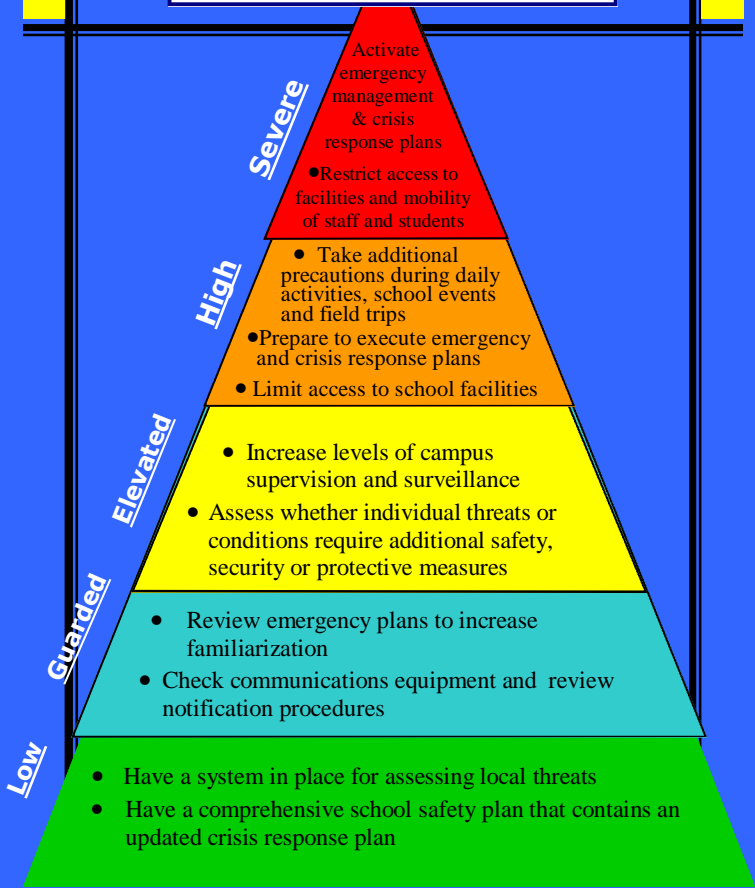
Law Enforcement's Safe School Threat Response Pyramid



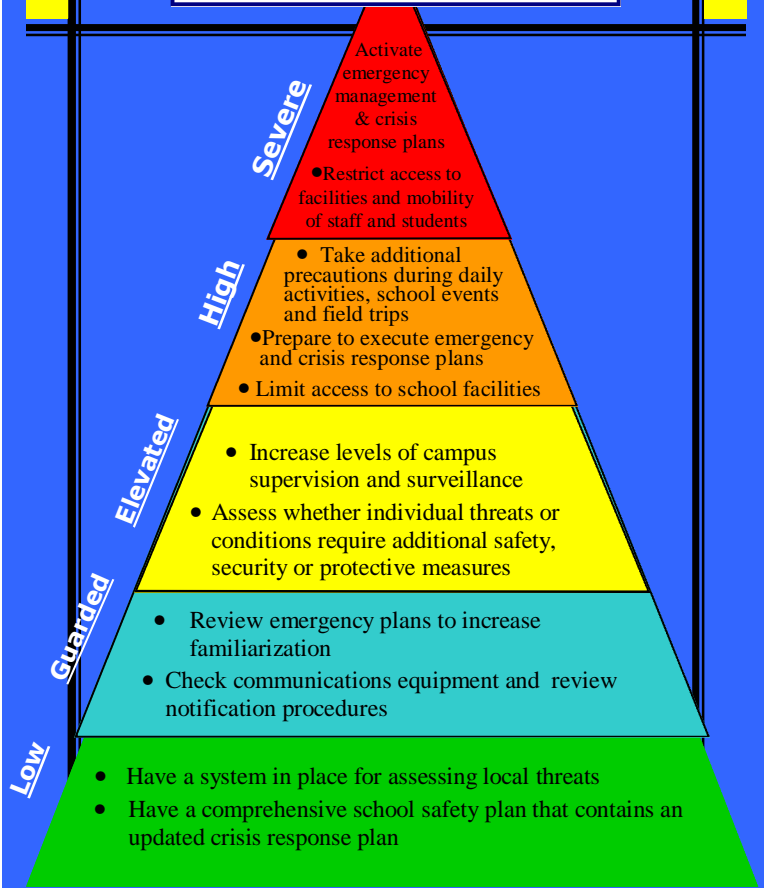
Law Enforcement's Safe School Threat Response Pyramid
