Law enforcement agencies should actively partner with their local colleges and universities to assist with *safe campus* planning, preparation and practice.

- **PLANNING** includes the development of Campus Safety Teams and Crisis Response Teams, the assigning of roles and responsibilities, and the development of a comprehensive ICS-based crisis response and emergency management plan.
- **PREPAREDNESS** includes training at all levels of the organization, personnel qualifications, certification standards, and equipment acquisition and certification standards.
- **PRACTICE** for emergency responders and university officials is essential and includes training scenarios, role-playing, tabletop activities, all standard campus safety drills, and full-scale situation simulations.

**Campus crime is not just limited to high profile incidents but includes offenses such as assaults, harassment, violence and suicides.**

**Local law enforcement agencies and their university partners should work together to ensure that all students, faculty and staff have a safe and secure environment.**
